## Reflection on Today's Scripture:

*No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is often called the neglected person of the Trinity, but this is not true. We couldn't even believe in the Trinity without the work of the Holy Spirit. Today God reminds us of what Jesus said: if we want to proclaim His good news, it is not us who will speak but the Spirit. This was what led St. Francis to be so bold, his trust that God could use even a "poor instrument" like him. Today we ask God to open our ears to hear his word and our voices to proclaim the good news: Jesus lives! God bless! Fr. Bobby*
