Reflections on the Wisdom from St. Francis

“Those who are placed over others should boast of it as much as if they were assigned to wash their feet.” Admonition 4.

Francis in his early life was obsessed with status, with wanting to be ahead of others, to be on top. When he chose to be a lesser brother, a friar minor, he tried to reject any status. Yet, he was founder of a religious order and was for many years in charge. He was always tempted to think that he *should be in charge*, that this was his right. But as always, he was faced with the gospel message and the example of Jesus, who came “not to be served but to serve.” So Francis chose as his model of true leadership the *mandatum*, that is, the example of Jesus at the Last Supper who washed His disciples’ feet and told them to do the same. Leadership in Francis’ eyes was not about power, or status, or any of the ‘perks.’ To lead is to serve, and to wash the feet of others. How wonderful a vision, and how difficult to learn! But Francis once more shows us that it is worth it, because in this way daily we can learn how to be like Jesus, our brother and our Savior. May the Lord watch over you every day!

ASSISI PARDON

PORZIUNCULA PARDON is always available under the conditions the Catholic Church has stipulated.

The conditions for receiving the Porziuncola Pardon are:

To receive the Porziuncola Indulgence, one must receive sacramental absolution and receive Holy Communion at Mass. Additionally, one must visit a church where one prays at least the Creed and an Our Father for the intentions of the Pope. Additionally, one must be completely free of any attachment to sin; if this condition is not met, the indulgence is partial rather than plenary.

At the National Shrine of St. Francis of Assisi, the Pardon of Assisi may be received on October 4th, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi (in the Shrine Church); on any two days of one’s own choosing during the year (one day in the Church and one day in the Porziuncula Nuova); and as often as one makes a formal pilgrimage as part of a group to the Shrine Church or to the Porziuncula Nuova. (One may receive a plenary indulgence only once a day and it may be applied to oneself or to the soul of one of the faithfully departed.)


